

## Simple twist beret



DK weight yarn.

3mm and 3.25mm circular or dpn needles

Start with a normal knit cast on 120 stitches. With a 3mm circular. I used two for ease, saves having the right size needle.

\*K2tbl, p2\* for 15 rows in the round.

Move to 3.25mm needle

\*kfb, k\* for one round. 180st

knit 5 rounds.

Place markers every 10 stitches.

\*k5 m1 (by lifting loop below from the front with left needle and knitting through the back of the loop) K5\* for one round 198 st

knit 4 rounds

\*k5 m1 k1 m1 k5\* for one round 234st.

knit 3 rounds. (I did two but I think it needs one more)

Keep the 1st marker and take out the 2nd and 3rd marker. all around the hat leaving 6 markers.

1,4,7,10,13,16 out of 18. There should be 39 stitches between each marker.

\*k2tog tbl, knit to next marker\* repeat this simple one step until you have 12 stitches. All sections should reduce by one every single round.

k2tog 6 times. 6st

k2tog 3 times 3st

knit i-cord with 3 stitches for 3 rows. Tie in ends and tuck the i-cord back through a gap.
